## Medical Assistant NCMA

Exam Fee: \$119

## Accredited by NCCA

Medical assistants are allied healthcare professionals who are responsible for various clinical and/or administrative duties. They perform clinical functions including but not limited to direct patient care and preparation, ECG, phlebotomy, and pharmacology while maintaining patient safety and confidentiality. They may also perform administrative duties such as scheduling appointments, maintaining patient records, bookkeeping, and billing and insurance processing.

## **Medical Office Assistant NCMOA**

Exam Fee: \$119

## Accredited by NCCA

Medical Office Assistants are allied health professionals who are responsible for various medical office administrative tasks beginning with initial patient contact through final payment. They perform front office functions such as scheduling, communicating (with healthcare professionals, patients and third party payers), handling medical records, and financial management while maintaining compliance with state and federal regulations.

## **ECG** Technician NCET

Exam Fee: \$119

## Accredited by NCCA

ECG Technicians are allied health professionals who are responsible for performing diagnostic tests to assess the patient's heart rhythm and rate. They ensure proper electrode placement on the patient, record the ECG, prepare the report for the physician, ensure patient comfort and safety, and troubleshoot abnormalities with the recording.

## **Phlebotomy Technician NCPT**

Phlebotomy technicians are healthcare professionals

responsible for obtaining patient specimens. They can perform various functions such as venipuncture, microcollection, and specimen processing and handling while maintaining patient safety and confidentiality.

## **Tech in Surgery** TS-C (NCCT)

Surgical technologists are allied health professionals who are responsible for various tasks pre, intra, and post operatively. They maintain asepsis during surgery, anticipating the surgeon's needs while remaining attentive to all aspects of the surgical procedure to ensure a safe environment for the patient.

## **Insurance and Coding Specialist NCICS**

Insurance and Coding Specialists provide medical billing and coding services to physician's offices and medical specialty practices for health care providers to be paid for services rendered. Insurance and Coding Specialists prepare and submit claims to insurance companies and prepare and send statements to patients.

## **Patient Care Technician NCPCT**

Exam Fee: \$119

Patient care technicians are allied health professionals who provide direct patient care within their regulated scope of practice. They perform basic nursing assistant tasks (as delegated by the nursing or medical staff) which may include obtaining patient vital signs and other data, communicating with the healthcare team and patients, assisting with activities of daily living (ADLs), complying with confidentiality requirements, and performing ECGs and phlebotomy tasks.

## Certified Postsecondary Instructor® Exam Fee: \$119 **CPI**®

Certified Postsecondary Instructor® (CPI®) certification is designed primarily for individuals who act in a teaching capacity in postsecondary career or technical college educational programs or healthcare institutions. Candidates are typically subject matter experts who have been hired to train or instruct others, but do not possess an academic background in education.

## **Certified Home Health Aide** CHHA

Exam Fee: \$70

Certified Home Health Aides support individuals in the comfort of their own homes with daily living such as bathing, dressing, meal preparation, and medication management. CHHAs are highly valued for their dedication, compassion, and ability to maintain the dignity and independence of their clients, making it a truly rewarding profession.

## **Our Pathways**

These are the four most common ways candidates qualify to take a certification exam.

## **Current High School Student**

Are you a CURRENT High School Student in an allied health program from an NCCT (authorized) school?

- You must be a United States high school student.
- Upon obtaining a passing score on an NCCT certification exam, you will receive a provisional certification.
- Upon graduation you must submit a copy of your diploma, certificate of completion, or official (signed) transcript with graduation date to obtain full certification.
- All required documents must be submitted within TWO (2) years after graduation in order for your certification to be released.

## **Current Non-High School Student**

Are you a CURRENT Non-High School Student in an allied health program from an NCCT (authorized) school?

- You must be a United States high school graduate or hold equivalent credentials (e.g., GED).
- You must submit a copy of your diploma, certificate of completion, or official (signed) transcript with graduation date to obtain full certification.
- All required documents must be submitted within TWO (2) years after successful program completion in order for your certification to be released.



## Graduate

Are you a GRADUATE from an allied health program from an NCCT (authorized) school within the past FIVE (5) years?

- You must be a United States high school graduate or hold equivalent credentials (e.g., GED).
- You must submit a copy of your diploma, certificate of completion, or transcript with graduation date.
   This includes U.S. Department of Labor Registered Apprenticeship programs.

## Experience

You have one year of verifiable full-time experience as an allied health professional within the past FIVE (5) years.

- You must be a United States high school graduate or hold equivalent credentials (e.g., GED).
- You must have ONE (1) year of full-time employment or equivalent working in your related field under direct supervision within the past FIVE (5) years.
- You must submit a copy of your high school diploma (or equivalent) and the Qualification by Experience form completed by your employer.

## **Military**

Have you completed allied healthcare training during U.S. Military service within the past FIVE (5)years?

- You must be a United States high school graduate or hold equivalent credentials (e.g., GED).
- You must provide a copy of a SMART transcript or DD214 indicating you have successfully completed a formal training program of the United States Armed Forces relating to the discipline for which you are testing. The DD214 or SMART transcript must be current within the past FIVE (5) years.


